INFRACTION	CONSEQUENCE
Uniform	Sent home to change (parents informed) Detention assigned Chronic infractions will result in suspension
Skipping class	School detentions assigned
Chronic skipping	Return to school with parent/guardian to create a plan of action
Late to class Students without homework/materials etc. Other minor classroom offences	Teacher determines consequences
Skipping teacher detention Misbehaviour in halls/eating in halls	School detention assigned
Skipping school detention	Two (2) school detentions assigned Possible Suspension
Late to school	Students will be given a warning for their first and second lates. Three or more lates will result in a phone call / letter to parents, community service, and possible suspension.
Cell phones and electronic devices	Will be confiscated and returned at the discretion of the level Administrator
Theft and/or vandalism	Immediate suspension Community work assigned Damages may be borne by parents Possible police investigation
Threatening or showing disrespect to staff	Immediate suspension
Use of tobacco products and e-cigarettes on school Property	Immediate suspension
In possession, under the influence and/or distribution of drugs	Immediate suspension Possible police investigation May be recommended for expulsion
In possession and/or use of prohibited and non-prohibited weapons	Immediate suspension Possible police investigation May be recommended for expulsion
Harassment: Physical, verbal, sexual, racial or homophobic	Immediate suspension May be subject to criminal charges May be recommended for expulsion
Cyber misconduct	Possible Suspension Possible police investigation May be recommended for expulsion
Plagiarism	Parents will be informed and 0% will be assigned
