### **What would be the responsibilities of a Home and School member?**

### **What does a Home and School do?**

- We meet regularly to discuss and make suggestions on parent/family/school related issues. A school representative sits on the Home and school to ferry information back and forth. The meetings are a more open forum for dialogue than in the Governing Board and since the Home and school also has a representative at the Governing Board, these same discussions can be brought forward in the hopes of finding a resolution.
- We also have a seat on the Quebec Federation of Home and School where bigger topics are discussed like the implementation of new laws governing English education. Resolutions are created and brought forward to the Government to hopefully implement law changes.
- We also do fundraising to help support the needs of the school; examples are the updating of the staff room for staff appreciation week, a water fountain that can also refill water bottles (located near the cafeteria), and school bursaries to graduates at convocation.
